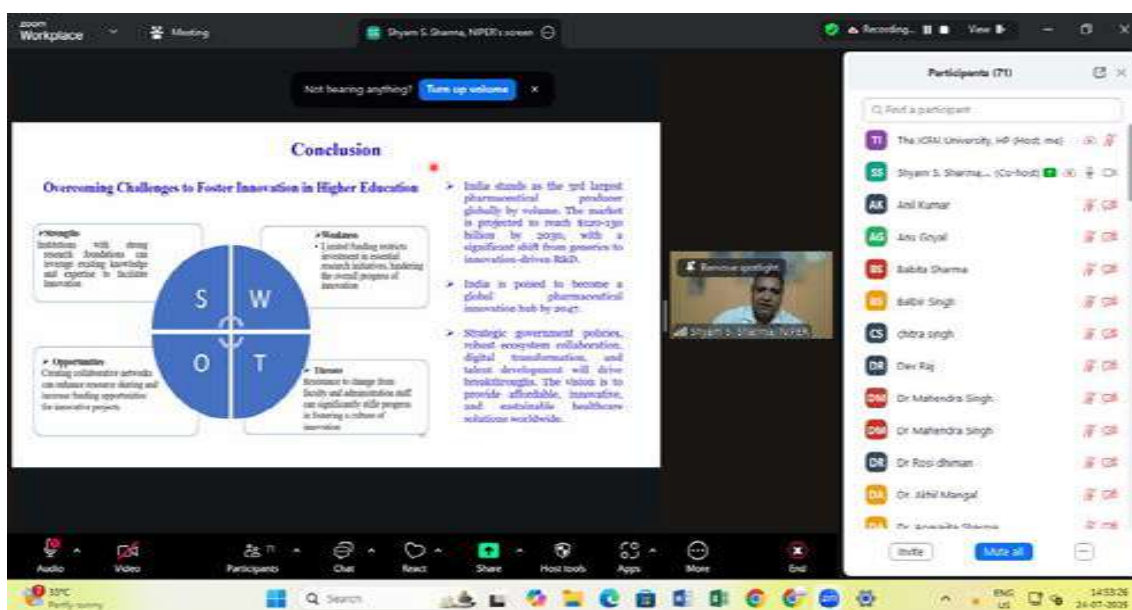
3. INSTRUMENTATION IN PHARMACY
