HOSTEL RULES AND REGULATIONS 2019

GENERAL

- 1. These rules are intended to provide a safe and conductive environment to the students residing in hostels of IUHP (hereafter called as 'the University'). Students in hostels are governed by these rules and regulations.
- 2. The Hostel Warden is vested with the power to enforce these rules and regulations, apart from administration of the hostel admission/re-admissions.
- 3. The Hostel Warden reserves the right to break open rooms in case of any violation of these rules, suspected unlawful activities or on the basis of perceived security risk.
- 4. If a student is expelled from the University for any reason, he/she should immediately vacate the hostel after clearing all dues on the day of expulsion from the University. His/ her continuance in the hostel will be treated as unauthorized occupation.
- 5. Hostel Residents with chronic medical problems as certified by Senior Medical Officer of the University will be asked to vacate the hostel room immediately, as personal medical care by parent/ guardian will be necessary.
- 6. Continuation of stay of a student in the hostel is subject to the discretion of the University.
- 7. No day scholar is permitted to enter the hostel except with written permission from the Registrar, IUHP.

LODGING

- 1. Allotment of the hostel rooms shall be made by the Registrar/Warden.
- 2. The students shall not occupy hostel rooms without payment of Hostel Fees and Mess Bills along with Program Fee at the time of Registration for each Semester.

- 3. Students must occupy rooms allotted to them and should not change/exchange the rooms without prior written permission of the Warden. Students must deposit key of the room lock to the Hostel warden before going on leave for more than five days to avoid any mishaps that may take place inside the room (like fire or any other incidents).
- 4. The University reserves the right to shift students from one room to another for administrative reasons.
- 5. Hostel furniture should not be removed from the rooms. Students are responsible for the custody and care of the furniture and fixtures in their rooms.
- 6. Acts of damage to the hostel priority like doors/window glasses/ bathroom accessories/ door mesh/chairs/cots/ DG cards for TV in the common room and Wi-Fi equipment etc are punishable as per rules and cost of the damages/repairs will be recovered from those responsible. Vandalizing the University property is a serious misconduct and action will be taken against the offender/s including expulsion from the hostel. In the event of damages to property, where students could not be identified, hostellers will be collectively liable to make good for losses caused.
- 7. If a hostel resident chooses to go on leave from the hostel, he/she has to inform in writing the reasons for the leave and duration of leave and obtain written permission from the Faculty Coordinator/Warden before leaving. Parents will be informed in such cases.
- 8. Water is an essential but scarce commodity. Hostel residents are requested to use water judiciously and preserve it. Leakage etc. in the bathrooms should be immediately reported to the warden.
- 9. Cooking in hostel rooms is not permitted.
- 10. The meal timings are displayed at the entrance of the dining hall. These timings are to be strictly adhered to. It is not obligatory on the part of the kitchen/dining hall staff to serve the meals outside the prescribed timings. In case any inmate falls sick and is undergoing treatment the warden may permit patient to dine inside the room.
- 11. Mess refund is not permitted under any other circumstances.
- 12. Hostellers are requested to switch off fans and lights and other electrical gadgets to save electricity, whenever they go out of their rooms.
- 13. Hostel residents are not allowed to keep air coolers, audio/video systems and televisions, electric irons or any electrical equipment. Unauthorized possession will result in seizure and confiscation of the goods. Students have to watch TV in the common room of the hostels where a TV is provided. Watching illegal/obscene/pirated movies/videos/websites is strictly prohibited in the hostel rooms or campus.
- 14. Playing of loud music and disturbing the quiet atmosphere by any other means is not permitted as it disturbs fellow residents. Earphones may be used while listening to music. Playing any kind of outdoor games inside the hostels/corridors is not permitted.

- 15. Partying in rooms/corridors/ anywhere in the hostel is not permitted whatever be the occasion. All students should celebrate only in the cafeteria, after obtaining permission of the hostel Warden in this area only.
- 16. Hostel residents are advised not to keep large amount of cash, or valuables in the room. The University is not responsible for any loss/ theft of belongings kept in the rooms.
- 17. Parents/Guardians are permitted to meet the student in a waiting hall with the permission of the Warden, after due verification of their identity.
- 18. Hostel Residents shall not participate in anti-national, anti-social, or any undesirable activity in or outside the campus. Observing religious rituals in common/ public areas is not permitted.

DISCIPLINE

- 1. Hostel residents should not enter into any unnecessary conversation, quarrel or altercation with the hostel staff. If anyone has any complaint against any employee of the hostel, a written complaint against the person is to be lodged with Warden. Use of abusive, vulgar and unparliamentary language against the hostel/mess/ security staff is strictly prohibited. Any complaint received in this regard will be dealt with seriously.
- 2. Hostellers should not give tips to employees of the hostel/mess/security.
- 3. Collection of donation for any purpose (religious/otherwise) is strictly prohibited.
- 4. Hostel residents are not allowed to put up notices or convene meeting within the hostel premises without written permission of the warden. Disobedience of this rule will be severely dealt with.
- 5. The University campus including hostels is declared as a "NO SMOKING" zone.
 - a. Procurement possession, distribution and / or consumption of tobacco, cigarettes and alcohol in any form in the Campus or entering the Campus in an inebriated condition shall constitute a serious misconduct for which mandatory fine of Rs. 1,000/- in the first instance, Rs. 5,000/- in a repeat offence, shall be imposed after due opportunity to the student to explain his conduct. In case of third misconduct of a similar nature, the mandatory punishment of expulsion from the hostel, apart from expulsion from academics if warranted.
 - b. Procurement, possession, distribution or use of narcotic drugs within the Campus shall constitute a very serious misconduct for which mandatory punishment shall be expulsion from the hostel after due enquiry. A repeat misconduct of this nature shall be expulsion from the University after due enquiry. The above actions are without prejudice to criminal prosecution under the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985.
 - c. Gambling in any form such as playing cards and betting on games is prohibited. All students including hostel residents entering the Campus shall have their belongings checked to ensure that they are not carrying cigarettes and alcohol. Any such detection will result is not only confiscation of such items but imposition of penalties as per rules.

- 6. Hostel rooms are subject to inspection by the University authorities anytime to make sure that they are kept neat and tidy and no unauthorized items like liquor, drugs, firearms, lethal weapons etc are kept in the room. Possession of any weapons or any instrument/contraption, which is likely to cause physical harm to others, is strictly prohibited. Mere possession of weapons or firearms constitutes a serious misconduct that may result in expulsion from the University/hostel.
- 7. Hostel residents are required to carry their identity cards issued by the University whenever they move out of the hostel/campus and present the same on demand to the security personnel to prove their identity. ID cards are not transferrable. Possession of forged ID Cards will lead to disciplinary action.

All students (both hostel residents/day scholars) have to register their finger impression in the bio metric devices at the main gate at the time of going out of the Campus and also at the time of entering the Campus. Not swiping and registering finger impression will be treated as misconduct and will be dealt with as per rules of IUHP

The University management is not responsible for any mishap or incident outside the campus.

Any overnight stay outside the Campus requires permission from parent/guardians given in writing and duly verified by the Warden. Resident students leaving the Campus should inform the Warden in writing and sign the resister at the security gate. Unauthorized stay by hostel residents outside the hostel without permission/ authorization is punishable under the Rules.

8. Campus main gate closes at 2000 hrs and opens at 0600 hrs (Summer timings) and closes at 1900 hrs and opens at 0700 hrs (Winter timings). No hostel resident will be permitted entry into Campus after mentioned timings without furnishing written explanation/ reasons for the delay to security at the main gate. Late comers will be penalized and the same will be informed to the parents.

Any boisterous/drunken behavior, abnormal gait will invite penalty.

- Entry to males is strictly prohibited into ladies hostel, except an University official on duty with valid permission. Likewise ladies are not permitted to enter gents hostels.
- 10. Perfect silence is to be maintained in hostel premises including rooms, bathrooms, dining hall, corridors, common areas etc. Hostel residents should have the civic responsibility that they should not be cause of inconvenience, annoyance or disturbance to others.

All instructions/ notices displayed on notice boards/ University campus will be deemed to have been served and read by hostel residents and excuse of 'not being aware of these rules' will not be accepted. Hostel Residents are advised to apprise themselves regularly of latest information/circulars/orders on campus net and notice boards.

11. Ragging in any form (making unpleasant noise, disorderly conduct, doing any act which causes or likely to cause physical or psychological harm or raise apprehension or fear of shame or an embarrassment to the new student), which include teasing, abusing, playing practical jokes on or causing hurt to such students or asking the new student to do any act or to perform such things (which such student/hosteller will not in the ordinary course willingly do) is strictly prohibited. If anyone is found guilty of ragging he/she will be expelled and also liable for prosecution under the Himachal Pradesh Prohibition of Ragging Act, 1997 which will result in punishment according to the provisions and rules of the said act.

- 12. Hostel residents must report any disciplinary matter or problems concerning them or their room-mate/ neighbor (s) coming to their notice to the Warden directly. In case any hostel resident's room-mate is absent from the room or is sick/ admitted in the hospital or is in any kind of physical/mental trouble or is indulging in any bad practices, it must be immediately brought to the notice of the Warden.
- 13. Hostel residents found guilty of misconduct or continuous breach of the above rules or of gross indiscipline or who are found to be a bad influence on the other hostel residents are liable to be expelled from hostel. The expelled students will not be allowed to opt for hostel accommodation in the future.
- 14. Any violation of these Rules will invite disciplinary action. The decision of the University in this regard shall be final and binding on the student, and the concerned parent/local guardian will not be permitted to question IUHP on any ground whatsoever.
- 15. The hostel residents will intimate the changes in his/her mobile number and that of his/her parent's and local guardian.
- 16. These rules and regulations are illustrative and not exhaustive. The University is empowered to bring in any new rules and regulations and or modify/amend/change/delete any rules anytime without prior notice.
