CONSTITUTION OF ANTI-RAGGING COMMITTEE
OFFICE ORDER

1. The new composition of the Anti – Ragging committee for the ICFAI University as follows:-

2. The above members are appointed by Registrar for Anti – Ragging & Disciplinary Committee for the Academic Session 2022-2023 are directed to observe the student movements and any type of teasing or ragging before the starting of the class work, during Lunch hour, after closing of the class work and university buses. If they notice any type of Ragging, they are advised to immediately bring it into the notice of Chairman/Member Secretary. All the members are directed to implement the following guide lines immediately to curb ragging within the university and outside.

- (a) Members are directed to prevent ragging within and outside of the campus. If anything found, members are asked to bring it of the notice to the Chairman immediately.
- (b) Members of Anti-Ragging Committee who travel in bus are directed to prevent ragging in their bus. The respective in Charge are responsible for their buses.
- (c) Frequent Rounds in the University and Surroundings.
- (d) Keep Close watch on visitor of non-students/strangers in the University.
- (e) Conduct awareness program among the student and counsel them if necessary.
- (f) Organize meeting with students especially with girls to advise them to regulate their own movements and interactions, especially with Strangers or undesirable characters.

(g) Advice Girls students to communicate to their parents and faculty, if any of ragging occurs.

(h) Hostel wardens should keep close watch on student staying in hostels.

(j) The committee will ensure that each student of IUHP becomes Signatory of the Anti-Ragging Committee as prescribed by UGC norms. Student will fill the online Anti Ragging Affidavit available on UGC website. One copy of filled online affidavit will be submitted to Academic branch and filed in student file for record. One copy of Anti Ragging Affidavit will be obtained by students parents/guardians and kept in record.

(k) If any type of ragging occurs, immediately conduct a meeting and recommend appropriate action to be taken as per the ACT of prohibition of ragging in Educational Institutions (26 of 1997) to the concerned authorities.


(l) Members are directed to conduct Committee meeting frequently and discuss day to day situation in the campus and inform higher authorities.

(m) Create peaceful and ragging free atmosphere in the University.

(n) The above committee will ensure the existing Anti Ragging policy in IUHP.
